

PARKING CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – 10/8

The major construction should be over by the end of next week.

The major construction should be completed around October 15th. Parkers that have been temporarily relocated should be able to return their original stalls by that time. You will be contacted when it is safe to return to your original stall.

There are a few small projects yet to be completed. The expansion joints running east-to-west through the middle of the structure are being replaced. You may notice rain dripping until this is complete. You will be contacted if you need to be moved if and when this is being done in your area. We will also be sealing the concrete and repainting the stall stripes and numbers. This will not affect any monthly parkers.

Daily parking should resume later in October.

Thanks again to all our valued parkers for your understanding throughout this project. We know there are some of you who have found your stalls unavailable when you have arrived in the morning. We are doing our best to keep on top of requests by the construction crew for space, and arranging a temporary relocation for you. If you find the crew has blocked your stall, please re-enter the structure and ask the attendant where to park. If the problem persists, please call Mark Hanson at the number at the bottom of this page and he will arrange something for you, so as not to inconvenience you any further.

Remember, we are taking every precaution to ensure both your own and your vehicle's safety. We thank you so much for your continued good nature and understanding in dealing with this project. We are happy that it has kept on schedule, so as not to inconvenience our valued parkers any further.

New parking rentals for covered stalls will open again about October 15th. We are taking names for the waiting list now. Roof parking rentals are available now. Covered parking will remain at \$75 per month, and roof parking will remain at \$65 per month. Parking spaces will not be changed once you are assigned.
