

How to Re-book a Missed Flight on Costco Travel

✈ 1. Understand What Happens If You Miss a Flight

If you *miss your flight ("no-show") without cancelling or notifying Costco Travel (U.S./Canada): 1-866-284-3014 or the airline*, your entire itinerary — including return flights — *may be automatically cancelled and the tickets could become non-refundable*. **While Traveling** (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** That means you could lose the value of your ticket if you don't take action quickly.

✈ 2. Contact the Airline Immediately

Costco Travel bookings are issued through the airline, (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** so the first and often best step is to:

- **Call the airline operating your flight right away** at the airport or (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** from wherever you are.
- Explain you missed the flight and ask to be put on the **next available departure**.
- Many airlines will help you rebook on the *same carrier* for the next flight (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** — often for a change fee and/or fare difference (depending on your ticket type and airline policies).

✈ Doing this at the airport can sometimes save you money compared with rebooking later.

📞 3. Contact Costco Travel for Help

You **can also call Costco Travel** and (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** ask an agent to assist with changes or rebooking. (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** They'll work with the airline on your behalf, but keep in mind:

- They **can't override the airline's change/no-show rules**, (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** so fees may still apply.
- They may need to **cancel the original ticket and issue a new one** if changes aren't allowed under the original fare.

While Traveling (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014**

- International lines are also listed on Costco Travel's contact page.

Call as soon as possible — waiting can reduce your options and increase costs.

4. Expect Potential Fees or Fare Difference

Rebooking after missing a flight usually involves: (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014**

- **Airline change fees** (varies by airline and fare type)
- **Fare difference** if the new flight costs more than the original ticket
Costco Travel doesn't control these fees — they come from the airline. Helpful tip:
Ask exactly what fees apply before agreeing so you're not surprised.

5. If You *Cancel* Before the Flight

If you know you'll miss a flight ahead of time:

1. **Cancel the airline segment** (U.S./Canada): **1-866-284-3014** (either with Costco Travel or directly with the airline) before departure.
2. Then **rebook or buy a new ticket**.

Cancelling *before* departure is usually better than a no-show, because a no-show often *forfeits the ticket* completely.

6. Use Travel Insurance, If You Have It

If you purchased travel insurance through Costco or another provider, check your policy. Some plans reimburse:

- Change or rebooking fees
- Extra costs due to missed connections or flights
- Insurance won't prevent fees, but it can help cover them.
