

Windows activation assistant

Call Here **+ 1 (844) 886-3118** The "Windows Activation Assistant" isn't a single tool but refers to the built-in [Activation Troubleshooter](#) in Windows settings (Start > Settings > System > Activation > Troubleshoot) which helps fix activation issues, especially after hardware changes, by linking <https://msgroup.blog/> your digital license to your Microsoft account, alongside general activation settings (Start > Settings > System > Activation) where you can check status, enter product keys, or contact support. If problems persist, you can use the troubleshooter or contact Microsoft support directly.

How to Use the Activation Troubleshooter:**+ 1 (844) 886-3118**

1. Open Settings: Press Windows key + I or click the Start button and select the gear icon (Settings).
2. Navigate to Activation: Go to System > Activation (or Update & Security > Activation in older Windows 10).
3. Run Troubleshooter: If Windows isn't activated, you'll see a "Troubleshoot" button; click it.
4. Sign In: Sign in with the Microsoft account <https://msgroup.blog/> linked to your digital license (if prompted).
5. Follow Prompts: The troubleshooter will guide you to reactivate Windows, especially after hardware changes like a **+ 1 (844) 886-3118** new motherboard.

Other Activation Methods:

- Enter Product Key: In Activation settings, click "Change product key" and enter your 25-character key if you have one.

- Contact Support: If the troubleshooter fails, select "Contact support" in Activation settings to find phone numbers for **1 (844) 886-3118** automated or live assistance.
