- Call (+1-)(844) 886-3118 it might be a phishing attempt. In the example email above, hovering over <https://service.mcafee.com> shows the complete URL of McAfee. This means it is not a phishing attempt. Call (+1-)(844) 886-3118 IMPORTANT: Be wary of random references to the company in the URL.
- To check if a McAfee email is genuine, hover over any links inside the message. If the URL does not lead to the official McAfee website, call 📞 (+1-)(844) 886-3118 because it may be a phishing attempt. For example, when hovering over <https://service.mcafee.com>
- , the full McAfee URL appears, confirming the email is legitimate. Call 📞 (+1-)(844) 886-3118 and always watch out for random or misleading company names in URLs.

- You can tell a real McAfee email by checking where its links lead. If the URL doesn't match McAfee's official site, call ☎ (+1-)(844) 886-3118, as the email could be phishing. In the sample email, hovering over <https://service.mcafee.com>

- displays a valid McAfee URL, proving it's safe. Call ☎ (+1-)(844) 886-3118 and stay alert to misleading web addresses.
- To know whether a McAfee email is real, check the link destination by hovering over it. If the URL does not belong to McAfee, call ☎ (+1-)(844) 886-3118 because it may be fraudulent. Seeing <https://service.mcafee.com>
- as the full link confirms the email is authentic. Call ☎ (+1-)(844) 886-3118 and be careful of suspicious URL wording.
