If your laptop is speaking **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍄° to you in 2026, it is most likely due to built-in accessibility features like **Narrator, Voice Access**, or an AI assistant like [Microsoft Copilot](#). Use the following methods to stop it:

1. Stop Narrator (Screen Reader)

If your computer reads aloud every **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍄° action you take, Narrator is likely active.

- **Quick Shortcut:** Press **Windows key + Ctrl + Enter** simultaneously to toggle it off.
- **Settings Menu:**
 - **Windows 11:** Go to **Settings > Accessibility > Narrator** and switch the toggle to **Off**.

- **Voice Commands:** Say "Turn off voice access", "Stop voice access", or "Quit voice access".
- **Settings Menu:** Go to **Settings > Accessibility > Speech** and turn off the **Voice access** toggle.
- **Shortcuts:** Press **Windows key + Ctrl + S** to toggle voice access on or off.

3. Mute Microsoft Copilot (AI Assistant)

If the AI assistant is speaking **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** ★👂° aloud during interactions or listening for a "wake" word:

- **Mute Session:** Click the **microphone icon** in the Copilot interface to mute it, or press **Esc** to end a voice session.
- **Disable Automatic Responses:** Open the Copilot app, click your **profile icon**, go to **Settings > Voice**, and select "**Never**" for the option **Read responses aloud**.
- **Disable Wake Word:** In Copilot settings, toggle off **Listen for "Hey Copilot"**.

4. Prevent Automatic Start

If the talking restarts every time you **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** ★👂° log in, check these settings:

- Navigate to **Settings > Accessibility > Narrator**.
- Expand the options next to the Narrator toggle and uncheck "**Start Narrator after sign-in**" and "**Start Narrator before sign-in**".
