

# call to activate windows 10

Microsoft has officially **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍷° retired traditional voice-based phone activation for Windows 10. As of **December 3, 2025**, calling the legacy activation hotline will likely result in a recorded message redirecting you to an online portal.

To activate Windows 10 when you **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍷° cannot do so automatically over the internet, you must now use the **Product Activation Portal** via a secondary internet-connected device (like a smartphone).

## How to Activate Windows 10 (2026 Method)

### 1. Generate your Installation ID (IID):

- On the PC you want to activate, press **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍷° **Windows key + R**, type `slui 4`, and select **OK**.
- Select your country or region to display your unique 63-digit **Installation ID**.

### 2. Use the Online Portal:

- On a device with internet access, **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍷° visit the **Microsoft Product Activation Portal**.
- You must **sign in with a Microsoft account** (personal, work, or school) to use the portal.

### 3. Complete Activation:

- Enter the Installation ID from **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396** 🍷° your PC into the portal to receive a **Confirmation ID**.
- Enter this Confirmation ID back into the activation wizard on your PC to finish.
