Microsoft has officially **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *#** retired the traditional voice-automated phone system for activating Windows 7. Calling the legacy activation numbers will now play a recorded message redirecting users to an online portal.

The 2026 Activation Method

If you cannot activate Windows 7 online, you must **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *#** now use a secondary device (like a smartphone) to access the Microsoft Support Product Activation Portal.

1. Generate your Installation ID:

- On your Windows 7 PC, click **Start**, right-click **Computer**, and select **Properties**.
- Select **Activate Windows now** at the bottom, then choose **Show me other ways to activate**.
- Select **Use the automated phone system**.
- Choose your location to **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *#** display a unique 63-digit **Installation ID**.

2. Use the Online Portal:

- On a device with internet access, visit aka.ms/aoh.
- Sign in with a **Microsoft account**.
- Enter your **Installation ID** into the portal to receive a **Confirmation ID**.

3. Complete Activation:

- Enter the provided **Confirmation ID** into the activation window on your Windows 7 PC to finish. **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *#**

Important Notes for 2026

- **End of Support:** Windows **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *°** 7 officially reached end-of-support in 2020. While activation is still possible via the portal, the OS is highly vulnerable to security threats without an **Extended Security Update (ESU)** license.
- **ESU Support:** Consumer ESU support for Windows 10 is the current focus; Windows 7 ESU programs have largely concluded for most users.
