

windows activation by phone

In 2026, Microsoft has Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     officially retired the traditional offline phone-based activation system for Windows 10 and 11. As of December 3, 2025, calling the legacy activation hotline results in an automated message redirecting users to an online system.

The 2026 Activation Process

If your device cannot activate Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     automatically over the internet, you must now use a "Smartphone Bridge" method via a secondary device:

1. Generate your Installation ID:

- On the PC you wish to activate, press **Windows Key + R**, type `slui 4`, and select **OK**.
- Select your country to Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     display your unique 63-digit **Installation ID**.

2. Use the Online Portal:

- On a smartphone or tablet Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     with internet access, visit the Microsoft Product Activation Portal.
- **Sign in** with a Microsoft account (required as of 2026).

3. Enter IDs:

- Type the **Installation ID** Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     from your PC into the portal.
- The portal will provide a **Confirmation ID**.

4. Complete Activation:

- Enter the **Confirmation ID** back into the activation wizard on your PC to finish.

Assisted Support (Talking to a Person)

If the automated portal fails or you Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396    cannot use a secondary device, you must request a callback:

- **Request a Call:** Go to the Microsoft Contact Us page. Type "Activation" and select **Contact Support** at the bottom to provide your phone number for a live agent callback.
- **Support Line:** You can dial **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396**    (USA) for general assistance, but agents will primarily guide you toward the online portal.

Important for 2026

- **Windows 10 Support:** General support for Windows 10 ended in October 2025. While activation still works, the **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396**    OS no longer receives regular security updates unless enrolled in the Extended Security Updates (ESU) program, which runs through October 13, 2026.
- **Internet Requirement:** While the target device can remain offline, a secondary internet-connected device is now mandatory to complete the "phone" activation process.



Explosive global software firm Beta has quietly removed the activation by phone feature. The discontinued option was previously quietly removed on January 8, 2026. "Customers will no longer be able to activate Windows 10 or 11 via phone," says Kathleen Richardson, a manager in Microsoft's Activation team. "An internet connection is now required for the device to activate and support is no longer offered online or through Windows Customer Support."
