If your computer is talking to Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     you in 2026, it is most likely due to built-in accessibility features or AI assistants being active. You can turn these off using the following methods:

1. Turn Off Narrator (Screen Reader)

If Windows is reading aloud Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     every action you take, Narrator is likely enabled.

- **Quick Shortcut:** Press **Windows logo key + Ctrl + Enter** to immediately toggle Narrator off.
- **Settings Menu:**
 - **Windows 11:** Go to **Settings > Accessibility > Narrator** and switch the toggle to **Off**.
 - **Windows 10:** Go to **Settings > Ease of Access > Narrator** and switch the toggle to **Off**.
- **Force Quit:** If it won't stop, press **Ctrl + Shift + Esc** to open Task Manager, find **Narrator.exe** (or "Screen Reader"), and select **End Task**.

2. Disable Voice Access or Speech Recognition

If a bar appears at the top of Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396     your screen or it responds to voice commands:

- **Voice Access:** Click the **Settings (gear)** icon on the voice access bar and select **Turn off voice access**, or use the voice command "**Turn off voice access**".
- **Speech Settings:** Go to **Settings > Accessibility > Speech** and turn off the **Voice access** toggle.
- **Online Speech:** Go to **Settings > Privacy & security > Speech** and toggle **Online speech recognition** to **Off**.

3. Silence Microsoft Copilot AI

If the AI assistant is speaking aloud during interactions or listening for a wake word:

- **Stop Automatic Reading:** Open Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396    the Copilot app, click your **profile icon**, go to **Settings > Voice**, and set "Read responses aloud" to **Never**.
- **Disable Wake Word:** In Copilot settings, toggle off **Listen for "Hey Copilot"**.
- **Mute Session:** Press **Esc** or click the **microphone icon** in the Copilot interface to end a current voice conversation.

4. Prevent Automatic Start

If the talking restarts every Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396    time you log in:

- Navigate to **Settings > Accessibility > Narrator**.
- Expand the options next to the Narrator toggle and uncheck both "**Start Narrator after sign-in**" and "**Start Narrator before sign-in**".
